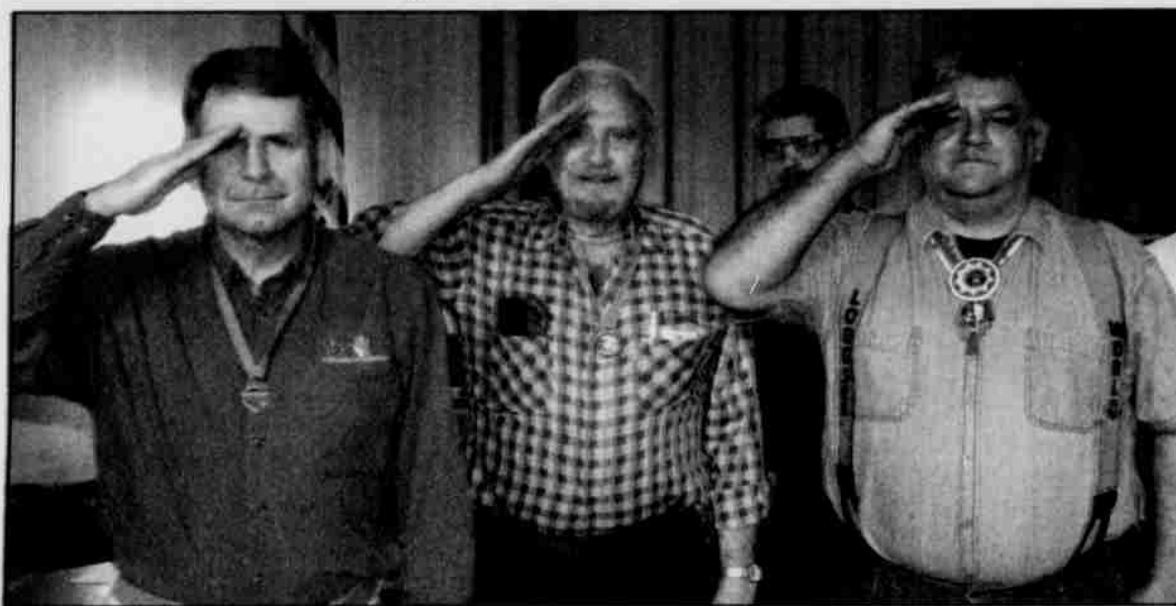


Veterans' Group Continues To Raise Funds For West Valley Memorial

NOTICE TO GENERAL CONTRACTORS

This request for Statements of Qualification (SOQ) represents a General Contractor (GC) Pre-Qualification process being conducted by the Grand Ronde Tribal Housing Authority in Grand Ronde, Oregon. Grand Ronde is located 33 miles west of Salem. This is also a request for Bid. GC's responses to this Request will be used to select the most qualified contractors.

The Project will consist of one site of approximately 0.4 acres located on a 29-acre parcel in the Grand Ronde community situated within Yamhill County. The project will be for the development of a sewer treatment facility for an Elder housing campus using Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde (Tribal) funds

The Grand Ronde Tribal Housing Authority is requesting proposals for the preparation of the site for the placement of the Membrane Bioreactor Equipment (MBR) for sewer treatment from qualified contractors.

Scope of Work: 1. Site preparation 2. Earthwork 3. Sediment and erosion control measures 4. Roadways and parking 5. Asphalt concrete pavement 6. Curbs, gutters, driveways 7. Miscellaneous utilities 8. Storm drainage system 9. Sanitary sewer system 10. Sanitary sewer effluent system 11. MBR plant foundation.

GC's wishing to be considered must request a Qualification Packet as provided by the Authority, and respond to the requirements put forth therein. Phone 503-879-2401 to request a Qualification Packet.

Qualification Packets must include the completed Qualification Statement, list of the primary team members, the answers to the specific project questions, and letter from the Bonding Company.
