Cultural Center Master Plan Community Discussion
Tuesday, Sept. 27 at Community Center

The Grand Ronde Tribe will hold a Tribal member community meeting regarding the Tribe's future cultural center and museum facility. Jones & Jones Architects will present their recommendations from their review of three potential sites and will collect comments and suggestions for use in preparing a facility master plan.

The Tribal Council is considering phased development of a facility. Suggested features of phase I are collections storage, exhibit space, classroom, office space and a gift shop. A later phase II addition to the facility may include additional exhibit space, a theatre/auditorium, café, and additional classrooms and offices. Tribal Member comments and suggestions are needed. Most of the funding for this master plan was provided by a grant from the Administration for Native Americans.
