## Community Discussion of Cultural Center and Museum Master Plan

— Preliminary Conceptual Design of Facilities —

The Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde will host another Tribal member Community Meeting regarding the Master Plan for the future Cultural Center and Museum. At this meeting, Jones & Jones Architects will present preliminary conceptual building designs to gather feedback. The first in this series of meetings discussed site selection and the Tribe's Davidson property by Ft. Yamhill was selected as the project site. The second meeting focused on facility space use priorities, building phasing options and blending the buildings with the site.

The Monday, November 14 meeting will consist of a presentation with open discussion to gather comments and input from the Tribal community. Ideas and thoughts from you as Tribal members are essential to help create a Cultural Center and Museum which truly represents your past, present and future.

The primary funding for this master plan project was provided by a grant from the Administration for Native Americans.
