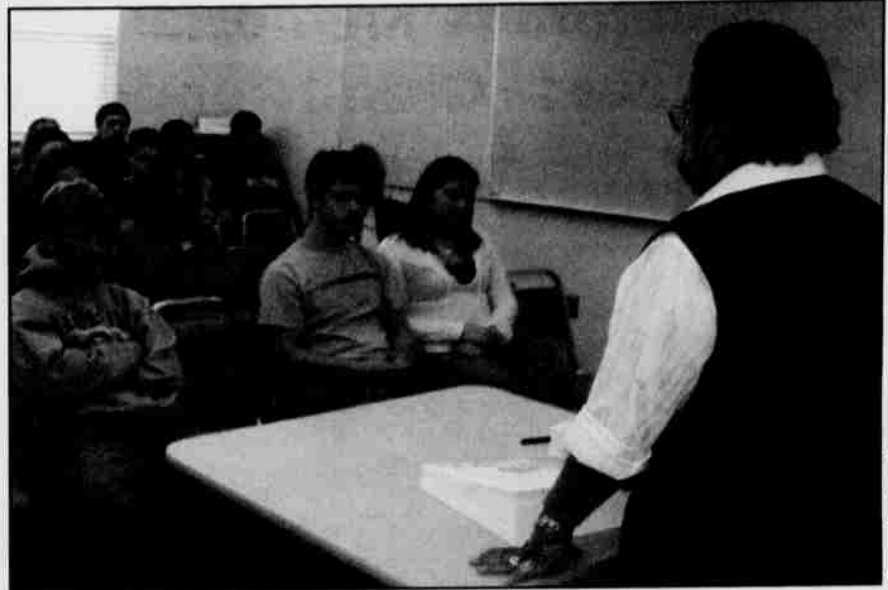
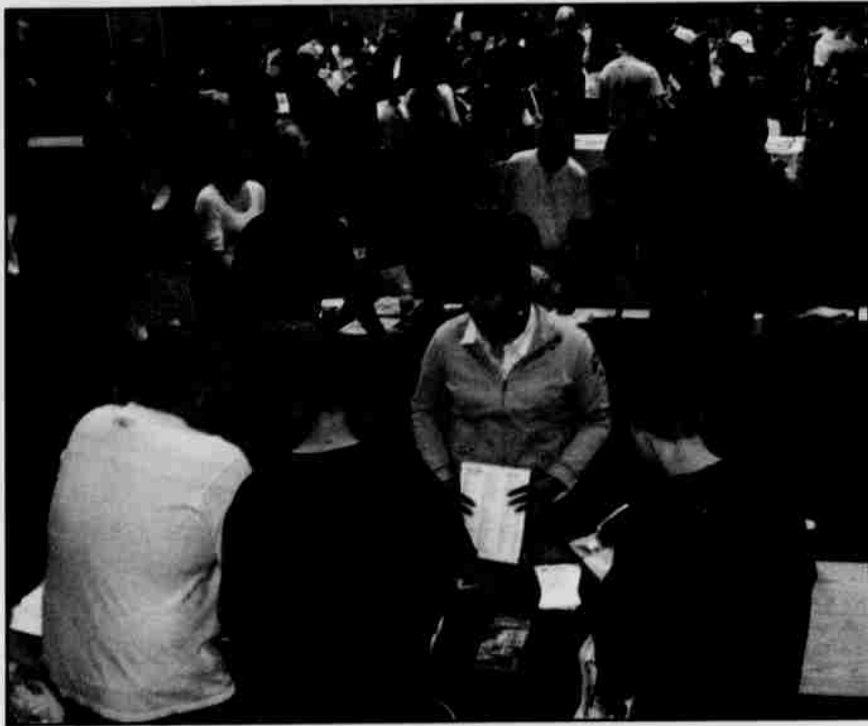


Education Hosts College/Career Fair

Full House — High school students (l) from area schools filled the Tribal gymnasium to capacity for the Tribe's College/Career Fair, held Wednesday, April 26.

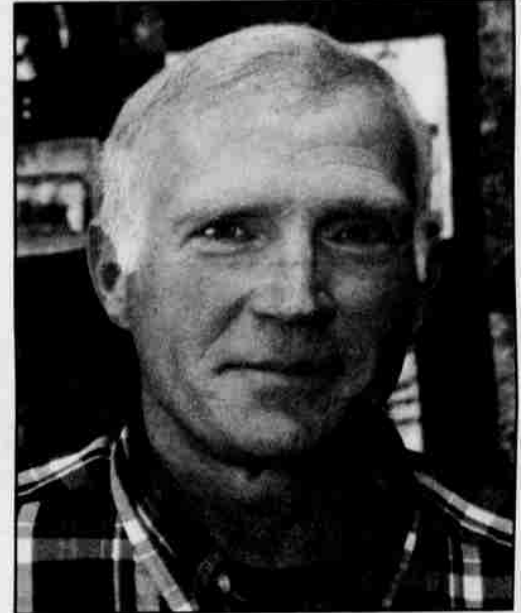


Community Historian Visits Tribal Elders
