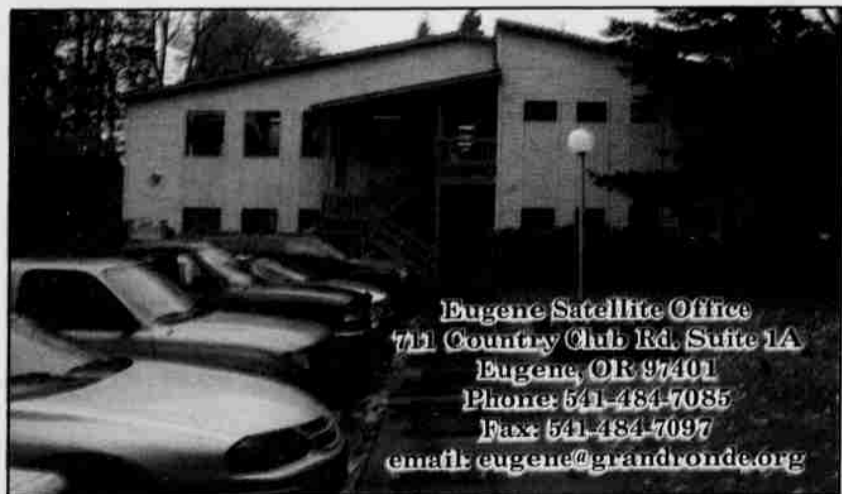
Beginning Beading Class-max 10 people. Class starts Wednesday May 24 1:30-3pm every Wednesday, for 10 weeks.

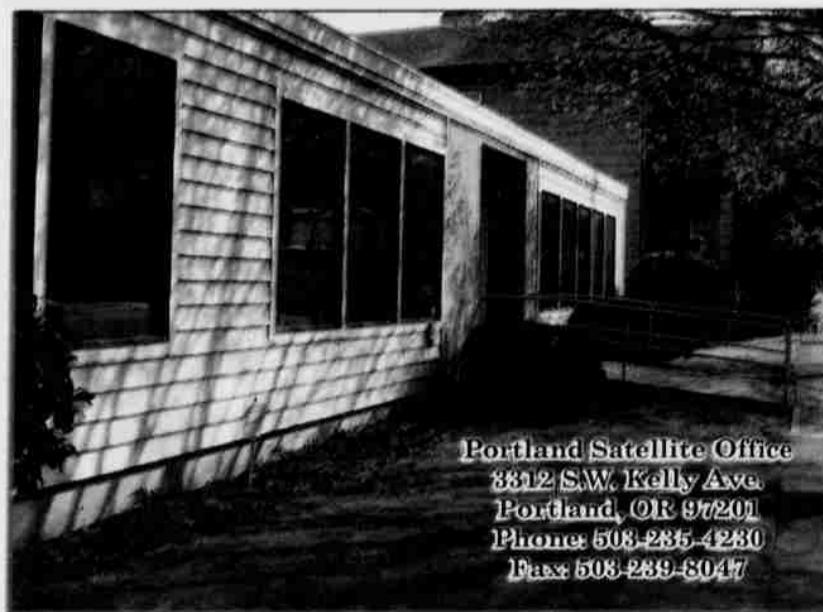
