## Spirit Mountain Community Fund Food Vendor RFP

**Event Date:** Thursday September, 13 2007

**Event Time:** 4 to 6 p.m. — dinner served at 4:30 p.m.

**Location:** New Tribal Pow-wow Grounds in Grand Ronde — adjacent to Fort Yamhill State Park

**Responses Due:** Friday May 11, 2007

**Requirements:**

- ◆ Vendor must be able to provide sit down, plated meals for approximately 600 people with a menu to include: salmon and buffalo, indian fry bread, salads and other negotiated side dishes and desserts (two options for each).
- ◆ There are minimal facilities on site so selected vendor must provide own kitchen, cooking and/or warming facilities to provide high quality food on site. Electricity and water will be provided on the site. Parking access to the cooking area will be provided prior to and after the event (due to end at 6 pm).
- ◆ Vendor will provide: a per meal cost estimate based on 600 individuals. Event coordinator will confirm actual attendance within 7 days of event date. Vendor will also provide any other fixed costs related to the event. The bid needs to include the types of equipment being brought to the site and the electrical requirements of the vendor.
- ◆ Vendor will include non-alcoholic beverage options — creative iced beverages are desired in addition to standard non-alcoholic beverages.

**Qualifications:**

- ◆ Vendor must have prior experience serving sit down-outdoor events with 600 or more guests. Any other special requirements must be included in the bid document.
- ◆ Preference will be given to vendors with prior experience cooking salmon, buffalo and Indian fry bread. If selected vendor wants to sub-contract for fry bread, they will use one of the identified Tribal vendors (to be provided if vendor is selected).

**To Respond to this RFP:**

Complete bid documents will include:

- 1) A brief overview of your company
- 2) The proposed menu
- 3) A detailed pricing outline
- 4) A detailed list of your rental needs—all rentals, including dishes and flatware, will be arranged through the event coordinator
