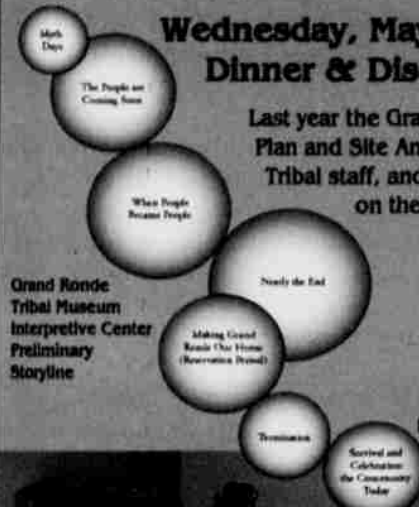


Museum Development Community Workshop
