Classes will be held 6 to 9:30 p.m. Sept. 7 and 21, and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Sept. 8-9 and 22-23. Receptions will be held 5 p.m. Sept. 7 and 4:30 p.m. Sept. 21.
