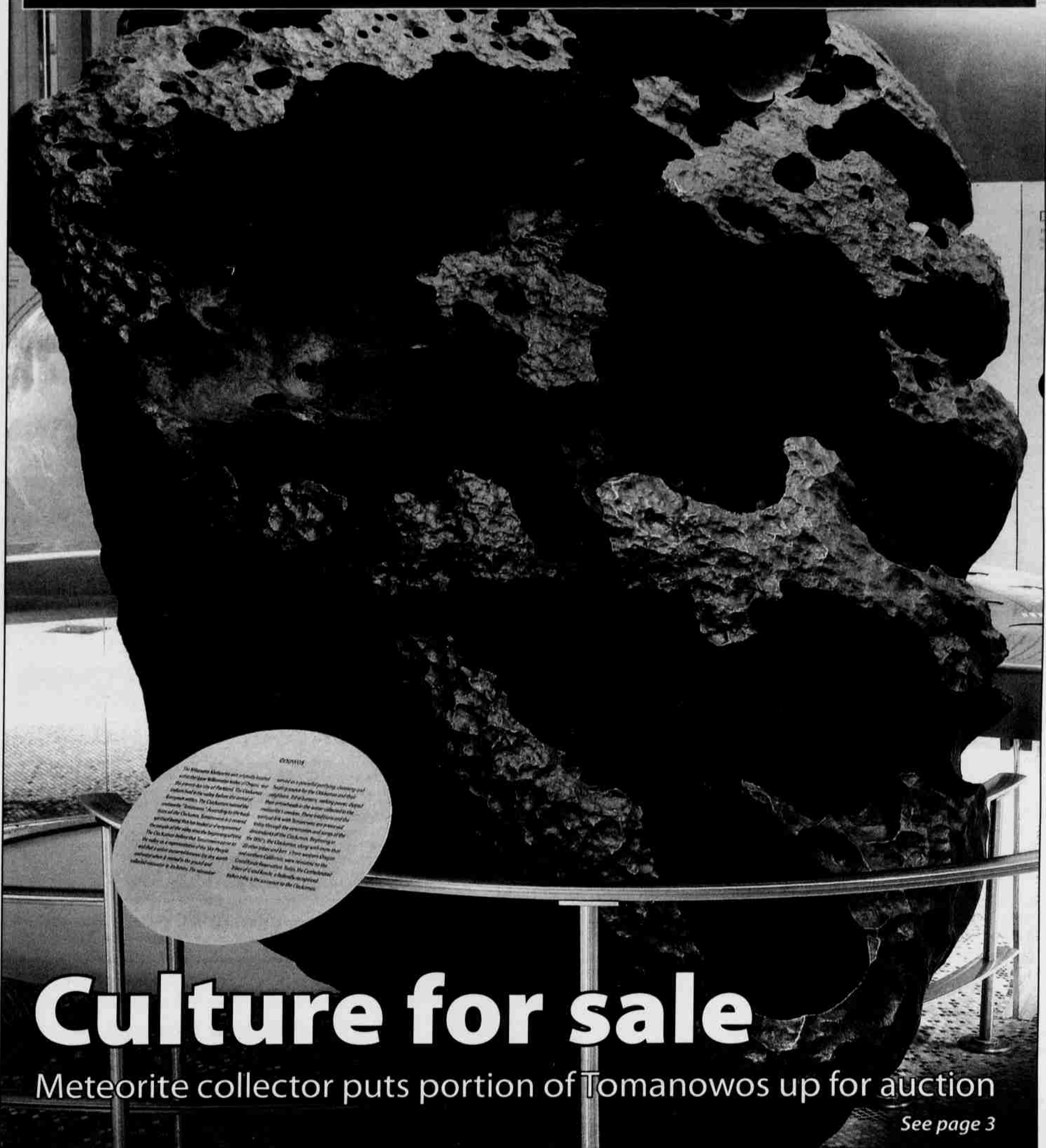

The Willamette Meteorite was a small meteorite that fell in the city of Clatskanie, Oregon, in 1802. It is the largest meteorite ever found in the United States. The meteorite is a chondrite, which means it is made of small, rounded grains of rock. It is also a nickel-iron meteorite, which means it is made of iron and nickel. The meteorite is a very rare and valuable specimen. It is currently on display at the Willamette Meteorite Museum in Clatskanie, Oregon.
