PAIRS is designed for Native couples who want to strengthen or improve their relationship through various communication exercises and the sharing of experience and wisdom.

The group will meet once a week for two hours each session from 6 to 8 p.m. at the Tribal Health and Wellness Center in Grand Ronde.

Snacks and coffee will be provided.

Participants must be eligible and registered for services through the Tribal Health and Wellness Center. The program is open to all Native American people, but is not designed for couples who are actively in crisis.
