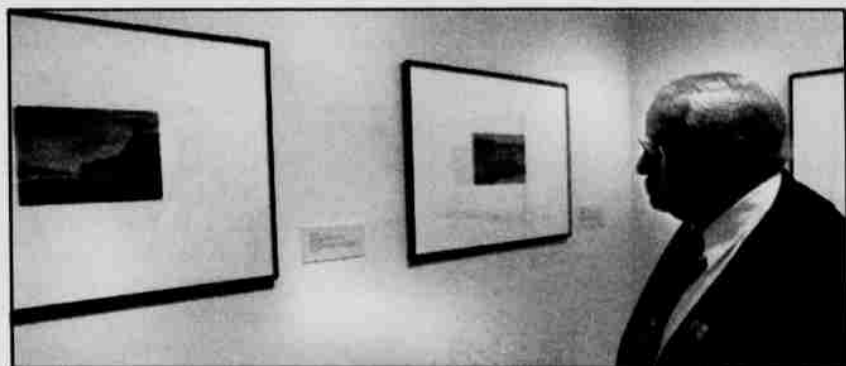


Eyeing 'Wild Beauty'
