Farm to feature Kalapuyan campsite

A new educational site involving consultation with the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde Cultural Resources Department is being developed on the historic property of the Parrett Mountain Farm outside of Newberg.

The farm, which already has a newly renovated farmhouse, will include a 1860s and 1900s farm site and a Kalapuyan seasonal campsite.

The Cultural Resources Department is working in conjunction with Parrett Mountain Farm representatives on site development, including building placement and exhibit planning.

Eventually, the Kalapuyan site will feature a full-size cedar plankhouse and interpretive signage providing visitors information about the histories and traditions of the Grand Ronde people, their current lifestyle and culture. Trails will educate visitors about native plant habitats and scenery of the Willamette Valley.

Grand Ronde Tribal members will have access to the plankhouse for Tribal use. A wide variety of cultural classes and opportunities will be available, including lectures, exhibits and a Family Farm Day.

"The Parrett Mountain Farm is very excited and thankful about this partnership with the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde on developing a Native American site where their story can be told," said farm Executive Director Elizabeth Rhode. "This site is paramount in fulfilling the mission of the farm in sharing with the public the land and its people over time."

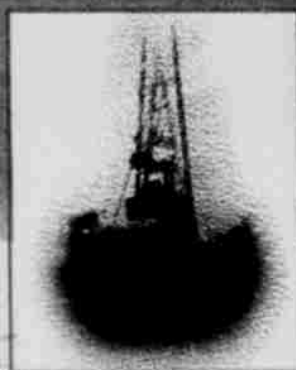

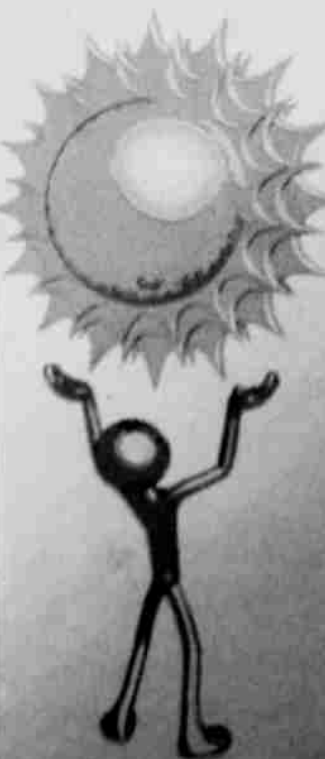
