## Bird bowling

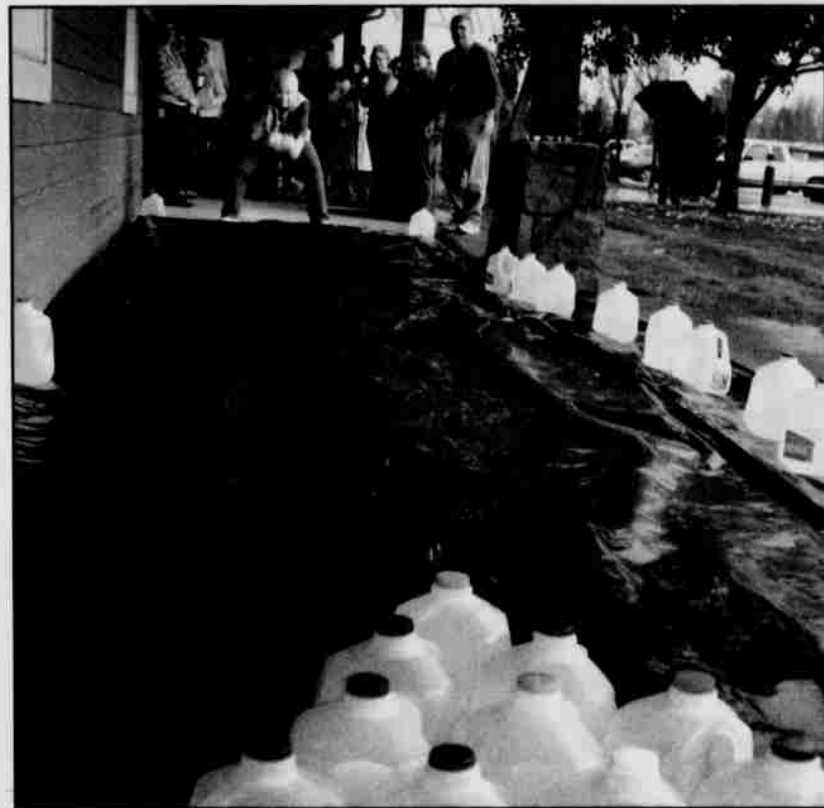
