Tribal Elder Delmer Leroy Croy Sr., 55, of Grand Ronde walked on June 25, 2009.

Croy was born Oct. 29, 1953, in Dallas, Ore., to Dellmore Franklin and Margery (Parren) Croy. He married Glenda Watson in Dallas, Ore.

Croy served his country in the U.S. Army and loved to hunt and fish, as well as make Indian jewelry and artifacts. He also loved racing and was a member of Total Destruction Racing's pit crew.

Croy was a certified nursing assistant and lived in the Grand Ronde area all his life.

He is survived by his wife, Glenda Watson-Croy of Grand Ronde; daughter, Elizabeth Watson-Croy of Grand Ronde; sons, Timothy and Delmer Leroy Croy Jr.; brothers, Edward Carlisle of North Bend, Ore., and Donald Croy of Colville, Wash.; sisters, Lola Foster of McMinnville, Ore., Vickey Briggs of Springfield, Ore., and Rita Weaver; and two grandchildren.

Services were held June 30 with burial at the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde Cemetery in Grand Ronde.

Nov. 13, 1920 - June 30, 2009

Tribal Elder Marjorie Marie Scheese, 88, of Portland walked on June 30, 2009.

Scheese was born Nov. 13, 1920, in Raymond, Wash., to Edwin and Alvina (Peterson) LaChance.

She was a member of St. Michael's Catholic Church in Grand Ronde and the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde.

Her family moved to Grand Ronde shortly after her birth and she attended St. Michael's Catholic School only through the eighth grade because she had to attend to family members in need. Because of the Depression, the family picked hops in the Monmouth/Independence area to help make ends meet.

Later in life, she worked as a nurse's aide at Tillamook Hospital from 1955 to 1965. In 1965, she moved to Cottage Grove, Ore. In 1989, after 50 years of marriage, Howard and Marjorie Scheese renewed their wedding vows.

In 1995, she moved to Portland, later residing with her daughter Anna Nystrom until her passing. She loved deep sea fishing.

She is survived by her daughter, Anna Nystrom of Portland; sons, Allen Scheese of Dallas, Ore., Larry Scheese of Vancouver, Wash., and Jerry Scheese of Portland; sisters, Georgiana Nichols of Portland and Betty Hyde of Astoria, Ore.; and 21 grandchildren, several great-grandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were held July 6 at Adamson's Sheridan Funeral Home with a vault interment at the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde Cemetery in Grand Ronde.
