For those individuals meeting minimum qualifications an interview will be given in the following ranking order:

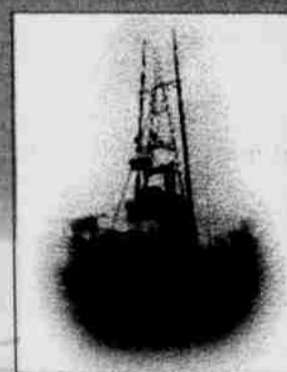
1. Grand Ronde Tribal members
