**What is an internship?**

An internship (full-time/part-time) is a real world experience related to your career goals and interests. It may, but does not have to be related /connected to your academic major or minor. Internships can be done during the academic semester and/or summer. There are several varieties of internships: some are paid, some are not and some offer credit towards graduation (from Stonybrook University's Career Center).

Not only are you gaining valuable hands-on experience, you are also networking and making connections to professionals in your future career field. - Good attendance record (fewer than 4 unexcused absences in the previous term)
- Good behavior (student must demonstrate maturity and good decision making skills - students who have had any discipline referrals in the past 3 months must submit an appeal to have her application read)
