Tribal members who have been separated from a job at Spirit Mountain Casino and would like to go back to work may be interested in a Life Skills class being offered by the Tribal 477/Vocational Rehabilitation programs in conjunction with the casino's Tribal Career Development Office.


Completion of the class will be a major consideration for being rehired at the casino, although Tribal members need to remember than every position at the casino requires obtaining a state gaming license.

The Life Skills class will help people identify and problem solve roadblocks to a healthy employment experience and begin to achieve life balance.

"Discover your full potential to be the best you can be," instructor Bonnie Kahn says. "Learn the art of eliminating self-defeating behavior and the joy of setting yourself up for success. Life Skills/Job Skills is a comprehensive eight-week course that will give you the skills to live a satisfying life at home and work."

Classes will be held in the Grand Ronde Community Center from 10 a.m. to noon starting Monday, April 11.
