- Must not owe a debt to the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde on behalf of Education
- Be an enrolled Grand Ronde Tribal member
- Cannot have been awarded a computer system or laptop through a previous Tribal Higher Education drawing

Eligible applicant's names that are received by Monday, March 5, 2012 will be placed in a pool and selected in a random drawing. The random drawing will take place on March 6, 2012. Students must submit an application to determine eligibility.
