Donations will be delivered to Doernbecher Children's Hospital in Portland.

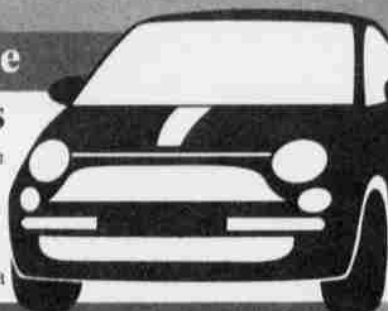

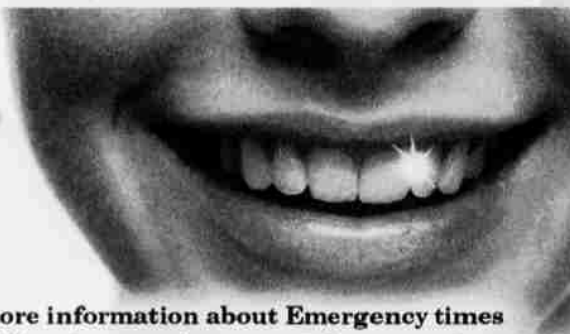
