### OPEN FOR COMMENT GOVERNMENTAL CORPORATIONS ORDINANCE

The Tribal Council, in consultation with the Tribal Attorney's Office, adopted, on an emergency basis, a proposed amendment to the Governmental Corporations Ordinance at the Dec. 12, 2012, Tribal Council meeting.

The primary purpose of the proposed amendment is to eliminate the requirement that Tribal Council must approve compensation of director level and higher employees employed by Tribal corporations, such as Spirit Mountain Gaming, Inc.

The Tribal Council invites comment on the proposed amendment to the Governmental Corporations Ordinance.
