PREVENTION CORNER

Hello all:

May is National Teen Pregnancy Prevention Month. An interesting fact that we should be aware of is that the United States continues to have among the highest adolescent pregnancy and birth rates in the industrialized world.



Parents play an important role in their child's sex education, but they also need support from society, starting with good sex education in school. Teenagers who receive comprehensive sex education are 50 percent less likely to experience teen pregnancy compared to those who were taught an abstinence-only based program. Recent studies conclude that declines in teen pregnancy are due to increased contraceptive use. Giving youth the tools they need to make healthy, responsible decisions will help them be more confident when sexual health situations occur.

The Youth Prevention Program, in collaboration with Youth Education and the Willamina School District, just finished implementing Level 1 of "It's Your Game: Keep it Real," an evidence-based sexual health curriculum at Willamina Middle School in April. During implementation, we served 127 seventh- and eighth-grade students. We received great feedback from students and parents regarding the program and will be back in the fall to implement Level 2.
