In 2008, the Education Division developed a five-year strategic plan based on information received from the membership. Currently, staff is working toward the completion of another five-year plan. 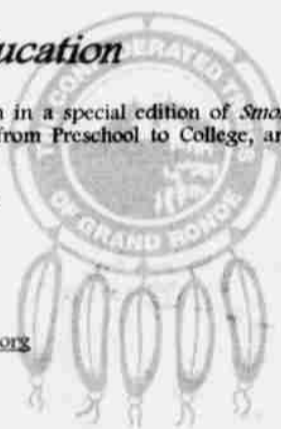
