Regalia

Dara Dickinson is the instructor for the Regalia making classes offered Thursdays from 4:30 pm to 7:00 pm at the CTGR Elders' Activity Center.

She began making regalia eight years ago when her daughter turned one, as she wanted her daughter to have a wing dress. Dara's mother-in-law taught her the way she had learned from her mother-in-law. Since then Dara has been perfecting her technique. She is always on the lookout at Pow Wows for new techniques, asking questions and checking the internet, always mindful to improve.

In Dara's class, she shows people the basics of regalia making and the easiest way to complete their projects. Her goal is to make sure that everyone has the knowledge needed to complete their projects or outfits. "One year in Siletz, I counted 12 outfits that were made in my class."

Dara is happy and proud to see so many people making regalia for themselves and their families, to see so many children dancing who didn't have outfits before their families took her class. Eight years later, Dara's daughter is still among those children dancing.
