## Encampment set for Sept. 6-8 in Central Point

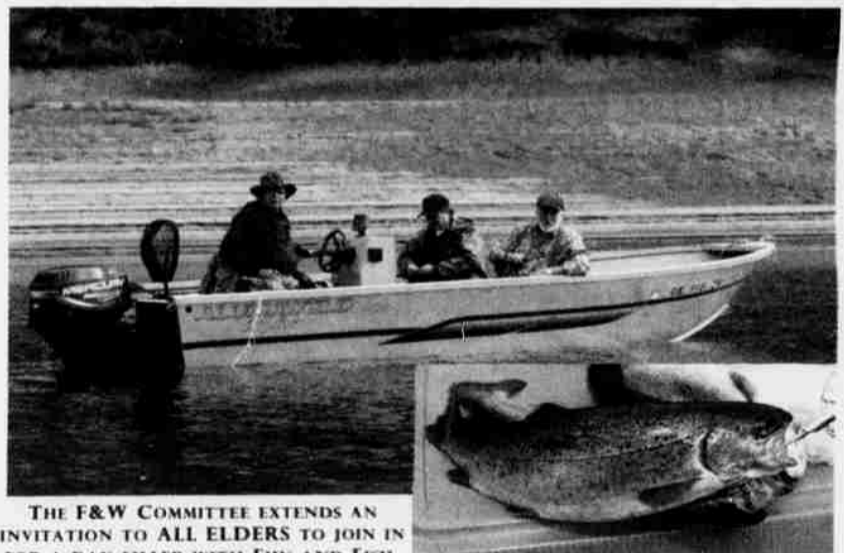
The Tribe will establish a Tribal encampment at TouVelle State Park in Central Point on Friday, Sept. 6, through Sunday, Sept. 8, to commemorate the Tribe's 1853 treaty signing at Table Rocks and the second anniversary of the Tribe's memorandum of understanding with the Bureau of Land Management and the Nature Conservancy.

A potluck dinner will be held at 6 p.m. Friday and Saturday and Tribal cultural demonstrations will occur from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturday. The demonstrations are free and open to the public.

The Treaty with the Rogue River was signed at Table Rocks on Sept. 10, 1853. In 2011, the Tribe entered into a MOU with the Bureau of Land Management and Nature Conservancy regarding management of the Table Rocks area near Medford.
