Charge is \$5 per space and vendors need to supply their own table and canopy. To reserve a space, call 503-879-2233. ■

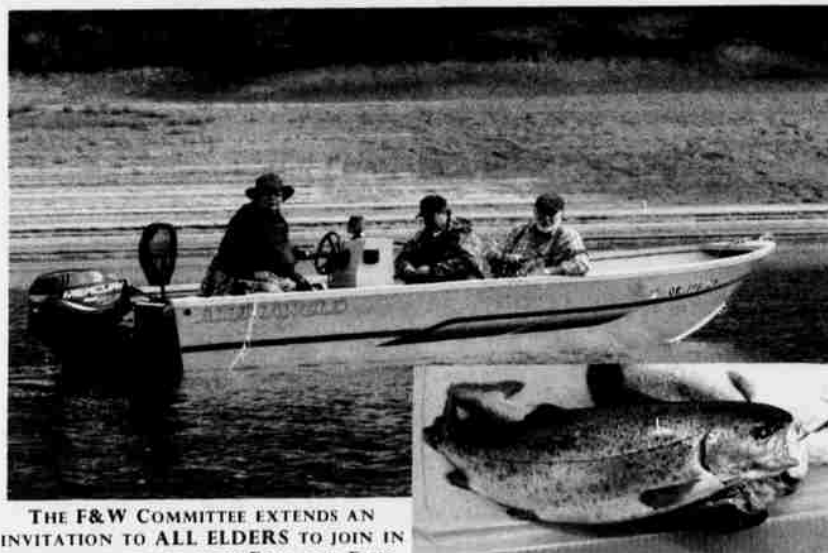
Education offers Chinuk Wawa classes
