



2008 – Tribal voters returned incumbents Kathleen Tom, Reyn Leno and Wink Soderberg to office during the Tribal Council election.

2003 – Tribal voters elected Cheryle A. Kennedy and Jack Giffen Jr. to Tribal Council while Jan. D. Reibach and Mark Mercier headed to a recount because their vote totals were less than 1 percent apart. Reibach eventually was confirmed as receiving the third highest vote count.

1998 – Tribal voters elected Ed Larsen, Kathryn Harrison and Robert Haller to Tribal Council.

1993 – Publications does not possess a copy of the September 1993 *Smoke Signals*.

1988 – President Ronald Reagan signed legislation creating a 9,811-acre reservation for the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde on Sept. 9. Reagan's signature immediately put the reservation lands, located in Yamhill County, into trust for the Tribe with the U.S. Department of the Interior. Meanwhile, Tribal voters elected Ray McKnight, Merle Holmes and Marvin Kimsey to Tribal Council.

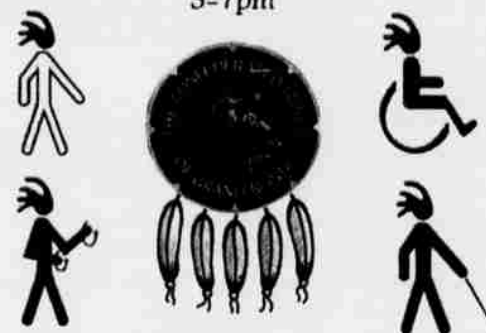
