In other action, Tribal Council:

• Approved amendments to the Tribal Enrollment Ordinance that streamline how quickly people can be enrolled into the Tribe once Tribal Council receives a recommendation from the Enrollment Committee. Tribal Attorney Rob Greene said the amendments eliminate a 30-day waiting period that was required from when Tribal Council received an Enroll-

ment Committee recommendation and when it could vote on the recommendation. "Tribal Council can act at the next meeting following receiving the recommendation," Greene said at the Feb. 18 Legislative Action Committee meeting.

• Approved the agenda for the March 2 General Council meeting to be held in the Tribal Community Center. The program report will focus on capital improvement projects occurring on the Tribal campus.
