On June 5<sup>th</sup>, the Tribe will host a public opening ceremony for Phase I of Chachalu, which will include 3,000 square-feet of entry and exhibit space. Operating hours will be Monday-Friday, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. The initial exhibit area will be open to the public during normal operating hours. There will also be special weekend hours during Veteran's Pow Wow Weekend in July, Pow Wow Weekend in August, Restoration Weekend in November, and possibly other Tribal special events with scheduling and advance notice. Outside of these times and events, exhibit viewing and tours will be coordinated by special appointment.

Between now and the June opening, we will provide a weekly tour of the facility every Wednesday at 10:00 am.
