Mending Broken Hearts training set

The White Bison Mending Broken Hearts training will return to the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde on June 18-20 at the Tribal Education Center, 9615 Grand Ronde Road. The purpose of the training is to offer a culturally based way of healing from grief, loss and intergenerational trauma, especially for Native American people in the United States and Canada. The training is free, but people must register to attend. Participants are asked for a three-day commitment and must attend from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day. The training is sponsored by the Tribe's Behavioral Health Program and funded through a Meth and Suicide Prevention Initiative grant. ■
