The event raises funds for Doernbecher Children's Hospital at OHSU in Portland. The Mr. Bulldog competition started in early March and featured 10 boys, each with a female escort. Contestants participated in myriad events on a weekly basis to earn points. Events included Dawg Jams, a dodge ball tournament and a student auction. They also participated in fundraisers from the sale of doughnuts, spaghetti dinners and bake sales. During the pageant, Fasana received the crown and title of Mr. Bulldog. Contestants raised more than \$9,000 and the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde donated \$3,000 to bring the total to more than \$12,000.
