Notice of planned ICDBG application & Community Development Statement Grand Ronde Tribal Police Station Project

Tribal Council reviewed options and selected the Grand Ronde Tribal Police Station for the Tribe's 2014 Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG) application to HUD. The proposed project is planned to be constructed at the Tribal campus. The estimated cost is \$707,000 including \$500,000 from this ICDBG application, \$167,000 in Tribal match and an estimated \$40,000 for police administrative space HUD has said is ineligible. An additional \$18,330 a year in facility operating costs is anticipated.
