Drug-Free Workplace Policy

- Effective January 1, 2004, all employees are subject to random drug and/or alcohol testing.
- All pre-employment offers.
- When there is reasonable suspicion.
- Post accident.

Internal applicants are

1. Current Regular Employee, past their six-month Introductory period, receiving at least a "meets expectations" on most recent performance evaluation and not under disciplinary action or performance improvement within the previous six months,
2. Grand Ronde Tribal members
3. Spouse of a Grand Ronde Tribal member or
4. Parent or legal guardian of Grand Ronde Tribal member children

Internal recruitment

For those individuals meeting minimum qualifications an interview will be given in the following ranking

order:

1. Grand Ronde Tribal members
 - a) Qualified Grand Ronde Tribal members who show they meet the minimum qualifications of the position during the course of the interview process will be given first consideration for hire and the recruitment process will end
2. Tribal member spouses, parents and/or legal guardians of Grand Ronde Tribal member children
3. Current regular employees

SAVE OUR SKOOKUM

It's time to start thinking about applying for or re-applying for primary health care coverage. If you do not have Medicare or primary insurance coverage, you will need to apply for a product through the Affordable Care Act (ACA) to maintain your Skookum Health Assistance Program coverage.

If you have Oregon Health Plan or your state's assistance program, be sure to contact that plan and make sure your coverage doesn't expire. Most state assistance programs require recertification on a yearly basis.

The Save Our Skookum (SOS) team will begin sending letters to Tribal members about applying for alternate health insurance coverage. Please be sure to make it a priority to reply to our requests in order to avoid any suspension of Skookum.

If you are eligible for insurance coverage through your employer, we do recommend that you apply for this coverage. If you have concerns about costs for employer-sponsored insurance coverage, please contact one of the SOS team members.

Remember, the Skookum Health Assistance Program IS NOT AN INSURANCE PLAN. It is a payer of last resort, which means any coverage you may have or be eligible for pays before the Skookum Health Assistance Program.

We do have Certified Application Assisters on staff at the Grand Ronde Health and Wellness Center who can answer questions about the Affordable Care Act and assist in the application process. Please contact:
