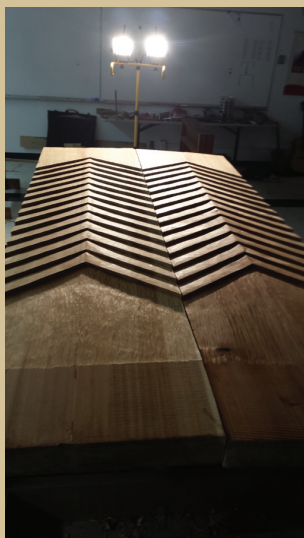

On behalf of everyone from Land and Culture at Chachalu, hayu-masi for a monumental year! In addition to the many ongoing projects and events we've had, the Tribe opened Chachalu, our first-ever museum and cultural center, in June with an initial cultural exhibit, classes, events and an operating state-of-the-art collection center to care for Tribal artifacts. Since its launch, there has been a steady flow of visitors and tours. We opened with special presentations and tours for Tribal members during Powwow and Restoration weekends. Recognizing that one of the goals set by Tribal Council is the establishment of a museum/cultural center that is of high quality while financially sustainable, the Land and Culture Department adopted the management of Chachalu into our existing operations.

Earlier this year, we added an oral history project that honors Tribal veterans and their families. Veterans are invited to share important stories of how they served the country. In 2015, oral histories will continue for our Tribal Elders and veterans. In the future, we are offering new projects for others to share their experiences and document them for history archives/future exhibits. These include past and present Tribal Royalty, Tribal committee members, Tribal Council and our Elders. For that matter if anyone would like to share a story or history about the Tribe, please feel free to contact us.

It is truly a blessing to be part of this great circle of culture. *khanawi ntsay ka-ixt-tilixam ntsayka* - We are all one family!
