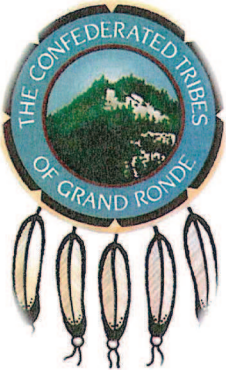
## Adult Members' Trust and Minors' Custodial & Rabbi Trust Funds

If you are a trust participant and/or if you are the parent/guardian of a minor member, you can access and review your balance and your minor child's balance by visiting [www.401Save.com](http://www.401Save.com). To log-in, the initial User ID is your (or your child's) Social Security number, and the initial Password is "00" followed by your (or your child's) membership number. Once logged in, you can customize your User ID and password for security purposes.
