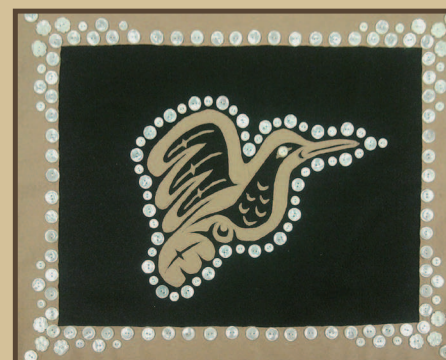

Chinuk Wawa Application

Last year, the Tribe launched its very own Chinuk Wawa language application for Apple users (iPhones and iPads). Which can be downloaded for free on iTunes by searching for "chinuk wawa" or "Grand Ronde", or by scanning the code at the bottom of these announcements.

The Land and Culture Department is working on an Android compatible version which is scheduled to be released this spring.

Chinuk Wawa Learning Stations

There is a Chinuk Wawa Learning Station at Chachalu featuring iPads with the Tribe's language application. Additionally, plans are underway to install a station at the Portland Office for Tribal Members to learn Chinuk Wawa. We hope to have that available there soon.
