Veterans SEB slates Memorial Day event

The Tribe's Veterans Special Event Board will hold the traditional Memorial Day event beginning at noon Monday, May 25, with a ceremonial meal in the Community Center.

At 1 p.m., the formal ceremony will begin with Veterans Special Event Board Chairman Steve Bobb Sr., a Vietnam-era Marine Corps veteran, giving the invocation and acting as master of ceremonies.

Tribal member Jolanda Catabay will sing the national anthem and Royalty will perform "The Lord's Prayer." The Grand Ronde Honor Guard will post the colors and Land and Culture Manager Jan Looking Wolf Reibach will perform a medley of taps and "Amazing Grace" on Native flute.

Speakers will include Cameron Smith, director of the Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs; Tribal Council Chairman Reyn Leno, also a Vietnam-era Marine Corps veteran; and Jerry Wilson, Yamhill County Veterans' Services officer.

The names of veterans being added to the West Valley Veterans Memorial also will be read. ■

First Fish Ceremony set for May 8

The third annual First Fish Ceremony on the banks of the Willamette River will be held at 4:30 p.m. Friday, May 8, at the McLean House, 5350 River St., West Linn.

The ceremony is held annually to commemorate the return of Tribal relatives to the waterways of Oregon. The return of salmon has always signified survival for Tribal ancestors in the form of a valuable food source. The Tribe continues to celebrate the arrival of the fish, commemorate their journey and work to ensure their return.
