

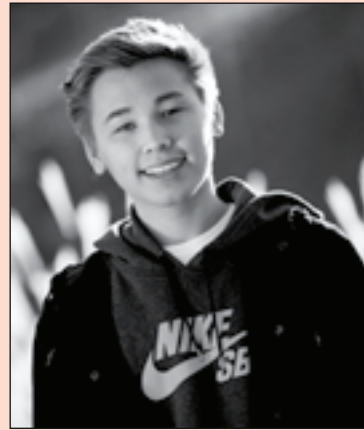


**Congratulations, James Pena.**

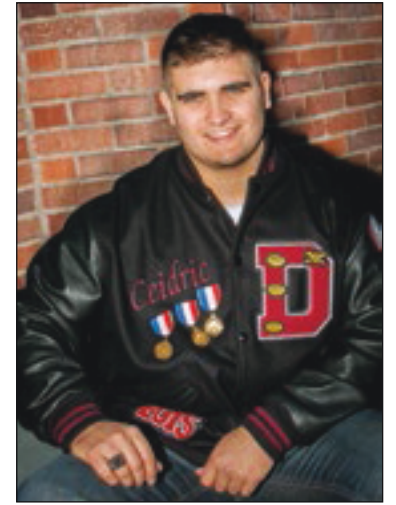
