The Clothes Closet, iskam mək'hmək haws and A Cause For Paws have started an ad hoc group called Grand Ronde Helping Hands and is inviting community members to join the effort of supporting local families.

“The goal is to bring those of us together who are supporting families in Grand Ronde to share the services and resources we provide and create a resource guide we can all use,” said Food Bank Coordinator Francene Ambrose.

“If you provide any type of services to families in our community, please consider attending,” Ambrose said. “We are looking for meal site calendars, food box sites, clothes closets, showers and laundry service. We are asking churches, church groups, departments and support groups to share with us. We are also collecting items for homeless families in our area, items for camping, bed in a bag, reusable water jugs, silverware, plates, etc.”

There will be a collection day at the Food Bank from 2 to 6 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 21, seeking donations of Halloween costumes, towels, warm clothing, shoes and bedding items.
