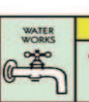
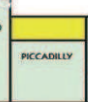

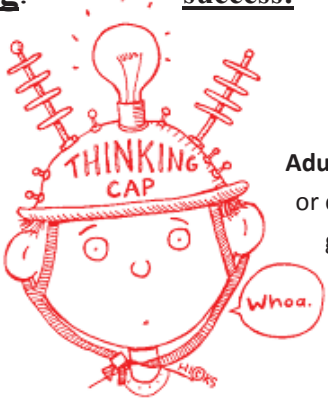
Four Reasons To Get Your GED
