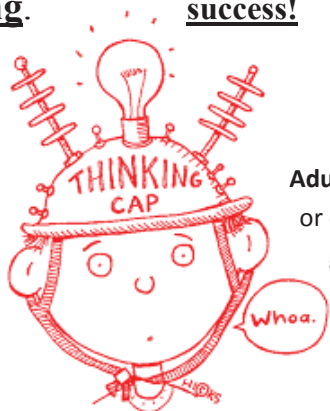
### College Placement Testing offered
