

Youth sought to serve on new Youth Council

The Grand Ronde Tribe is seeking youths in grades six through 12 who are interested in serving on the new Youth Council.

Youths who are enrolled members of the Tribe, direct descendants of a currently enrolled member or an enrolled member of another federally recognized Tribe receiving services directly from the Grand Ronde Tribe are eligible.

The Youth Council will act in an advisory capacity to Tribal Council, the Youth Education Department, Youth Prevention and other Tribal departments and programs in identifying needs and developing priorities concerning Tribal youth and youth-related programs and activities.

The Youth Council will consist of seven voting members appointed by Tribal Council. In selecting members, Tribal Council will give preference to youth who have maintained a good academic standing (minimum 2.5 GPA), maintained healthy life choices, demonstrated leadership skills and can travel to and attend meetings, trainings and other activities as needed.

Tribal Council likely will be selecting applicants for appointments by Feb. 3. All interested youth are encouraged to submit an application.

Want to see if a photo that was taken but not printed in *Smoke Signals* because of space limitations might be something you'd like hanging on your living room wall? Tribal members can order 8-by-10-inch copies of photos taken by *Smoke Signals* staff members regardless of if they were published in the newspaper. Charge is \$1 for each print ordered. Reprint orders must be pre-paid with a check made out to *Smoke Signals*. A photo reprint order form is available in the Publications Office of the Tribe's Governance Building in Grand Ronde, or can be mailed upon request.

All photos contained in *Smoke Signals*' current archive are available for purchase, but people interested in going through the archive must make an appointment to review photos for possible purchase.

No rush orders are permitted and requestors must allow 30 days for delivery. Requestors must be Tribal members.

In addition, reprint requestors must agree that the reprint is for personal use only, and not for use in an ad, or for commercial, political or promotional purposes.
