Book Review: “Chasing the Devil: My 20-Year Quest to Capture the Green River Killer” by Sheriff David Reichert

If you like true crime, you should read this book. You will get the real point of view from former King County Sheriff David Reichert, who worked these murder cases until he captured his killer, Gary Ridgway.

The next time you drive to Seattle or on Interstate 5 to that area after reading this book, you will not forget the 50 women who were murdered by the Green River killer. I personally will now say a silent prayer for these women every time I am on that stretch of Interstate 5.

You will discover that Ridgway is a creepy sociopath with more victims than perhaps any other American serial killer. You will learn how Reichert and the Green River Task Force caught the Green River killer. Also, you will learn how this killer is chilling and frighteningly shallow and absent from the bright side of humanity.
