The proposed amendments change the payment dates from the 10th day of each month to the 1st day of each month.

HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX ORDINANCE OPEN FOR COMMENT

The Tribal Council, in consultation with the Tribal Attorney's Office, has proposed amendments to the Hotel Occupancy Tax Ordinance. The proposed amendments were given a first reading at the February 3, 2016, Tribal Council meeting.

The proposed amendments include increasing the tax imposed on use and occupancy of rooms from 8% to 10% and may include other technical and formatting amendments.
