**Enrollment Process**  
 Applications available Monday, April 4 (Pick up at the Youth Ed Dept or call 503-879-2101).  
 Applications accepted (office hours 8 a.m. - Noon and 1-5 p.m.)  
 CTGR Tribal Member Youth: May 2 – 6 (First-come, first-serve)  
 CTGR Descendants/other Native youth: May 9 until full (First-come, first-serve)  
 Please note: If the K5 program is full, a wait list will be created. CTGR Tribal Member Youth will be placed to the top of the list.

**Eligibility Criteria/Intake Policy**  
 All students enrolled in the program must meet the eligibility guidelines listed below & provide proof of the following when applying:  
 • Student must be enrolled in kindergarten through fifth grade during the 2015-16 school year  
 • Tribal affiliation: Must be an enrolled member of CTGR (please provide a copy of Tribal ID or CIB), a CTGR descendant or other Native.  
 • Service Area: Students must reside in one of the six County service areas (Polk, Marion, Multnomah, Tillamook, Washington, Yamhill)
