


Eligibility Criteria/Intake Policy

- Student must be encolled in kindergarten through fifth grade during the 2015-16 school year
- Tribul affiliation: Must be an enrolled member of CTGR (please provide a copy of Tribul ID or CIB), a CTGR descendant or other Native
- Service Area: Students must reside in one of the six County service areas (Polk, Manon, Multnomah, Tillamook, Washington, Yamhill)
