TRIBAL EMPLOYMENT RIGHTS ORDINANCE OPEN FOR COMMENT

The Tribal Council, in consultation with the Tribal Attorney's Office, adopted, on an emergency basis, a proposed amendment to the Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance at the May 4, 2016, Tribal Council meeting.

The proposed amendment provides that the TERO Commission shall consist of at least three (3) but not more than five (5) individuals. Currently, the Ordinance requires appointment of five (5) Commissioners. The amendment will provide the Council some flexibility in setting the number of Commissioners.

The Tribal Council invites comment on the proposed amendment to the Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance.
