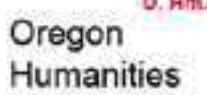

Opportunity for comment on Grand Ronde Housing Department 2017 Indian Housing Plan (IHP)

Under the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA), the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) will provide grants to Indian Tribes/Indian Housing Authorities for the development and operation of low-income housing in Indian areas. Grants are made to eligible recipients under the Indian Housing Block Grant Program. To be eligible for the grants, respondents must submit an Indian Housing Plan that meets the minimum requirements of the Act, and also submit an Annual Performance Report to HUD, and maintain records for HUD monitoring. The Grand Ronde Housing Department (GRHD) has received multiple grants under this program that were active during 2016.

Comments on the Indian Housing Plan are welcome and copies of this report can be obtained at the GRHD office or by calling 503-879-2401 or 1-800-422-0232, ext. 2401.

Comments must be submitted in writing to GRHD no later than 5 p.m. Friday, Oct. 7, 2016. All comments will be incorporated into the final report submitted to HUD. ■
