



Sunday, July 23

- Tribal police located a person of interest for the Polk County Sheriff's Office.
- A suspect in multiple crimes was arrested by another agency. Tribal police interviewed the suspect at the Yamhill County Jail and charged him with fourth-degree assault in connection with a case from April. The male suspect also was interviewed regarding several other cases.

Monday, July 24

- Tribal police returned to the Yamhill County Jail and charged the male suspect with theft, forgery, criminal possession of a forged instrument and identity theft.
