More than 40 Tribal members were briefed on the Tribe's overall financial status by Finance Officer Chris Leno during the Sunday, Oct. 1, General Council meeting held in the Tribal gym.

Leno gave a 35-minute presentation in executive session and fielded eight comments and questions from Tribal members in attendance.
