

# Museum seeks designs for Native American memorial

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The National Museum of the American Indian is inviting people to submit designs to build the National Native American Veterans Memorial, which is slated to open in 2020.

The international competition is open to students, architects, designers and anyone else who wants to submit a design.

The Veterans Memorial will be placed on museum grounds at the National Mall. A blue-ribbon jury of Native and non-Native artists, designers, scholars and veterans will judge the design entries.

The competition consists of two stages: An open call to submit designs and a jury selecting five finalists.
